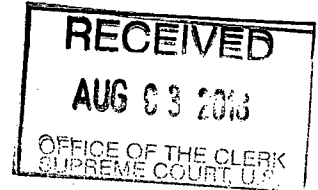

**MR. THOMAS'S MOTION REQUESTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI WITH THIS COURT  
FOR 60 ADDITIONAL DAYS TO INCLUDE OCTOBER 1, 2018**


Mr. Thomas was denied his motion for certificate of appealability by the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals on May 10, 2018. Mr. Thomas wishes to appeal this decision to the Supreme Court and has 90 days to file his motion for writ of certiorari. Mr. Thomas requests for an extension to include October 1, 2018 to overcome the obstacles associated with filing legal work with the courts associated with being a pro se and incarcerated individual.

Mr. Thomas is incarcerated at FCI Coleman Low federal prison in Coleman, Florida. This prison is subject to numerous lock down/recall situations daily. These are due to census counts, staff shortages, fights, and other security issues that inmates are never notified about. Most detrimental to the ability of inmates to access the things needed to prepare their legal filings is the

daily thunderstorms that come to this region of Florida. The prison is always locked down for these storms, which most of the time is all evening. This prevents access to the law library computers (12 of them), the one copy machine, and the 8 non-memory typewriters that are housed in the education department and shared by the over 2,000 inmates housed here.

As such, Mr. Thomas requests an extension of time to include October 1, 2018 to overcome these obstacles and properly file his writ for certioari with this Court.
