The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

RODERICK MCKISSICK v. GOVERNOR DEAL et al.

Applicant filed a petition for mandamus below, essentially seeking to challenge his conviction and sentence for murder and other crimes. The trial court dismissed the petition and denied the motion for reconsideration. However, an order addressing such an improper attempt to challenge a conviction is not subject to appeal. See Roberts v. State, 286 Ga. 532 (690 SE2d 150) (2010); Harper v. State, 286 Ga. 216, 218 (2) (686 SE2d 786) (2009). Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction to consider the application and hereby direct that it be dismissed.
