The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on December 14, 2017, and placed on the docket on October 29, 2018. The Court requested a response on November 14, 2018. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on January 14, 2019. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including February 13, 2019, within which to file a response.
