

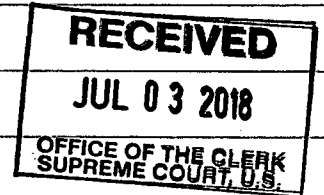

MOTION TO STAY

COMES NOW, PETITIONER, BRUCE WOOD
RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS THIS HONORABLE
COURT TO "STAY" THE 90 DAY TIME LIMIT
FROM "STATE COURTS" (REHEARINGEN BANC)
FOR THE FILING OF HIS WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO
THIS COURT (US SUPREME COURT RULES (1)+(3)) FOR
THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

① THE PETITIONER HAS RECENTLY DISCOVERED
"NEW EVIDENCE" AND OTHER NEW FACTS AND
INFORMATION THAT LED TO THE DISCOVERY OF
"NEW CONSTITUTIONAL CLAIMS" THAT IMPAIR
HIS "INNOCENCE,"

② THE PETITIONER BELIEVES THAT THE DELAWARE
"STATE COURTS" ARE UNFAIR AND UNJUST AND
HE WOULD RECEIVE JUSTICE IN THE FEDERAL
COURTS, BUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL

RULES OF PROCEDURE 28 USCA 2254 (b)(1)(A)
THE PETITIONER MUST EXHAUST HIS
REMEDIES IN "STATE COURT" BEFORE
RELIEF CAN BE SOUGHT IN FEDERAL COURTS.

③ THE PETITIONER BELIEVES THAT MOST OF
THE ISSUES PRESENTED IN HIS "NEW
CONSTITUTIONAL CLAIMS" CAN BE REMEDIED
IN DISTRICT COURT IN A "SECOND HABEAS
CORPUS PETITION", SO THESE ISSUES CAN BE
RESOLVED IN THE LOWER COURTS, (UNLESS
THIS COURT WOULD LIKE TO RULE ON
PETITIONER'S (SECOND) WRIT OF HABEAS
CORPUS).

④ IN ORDER TO FILE A SECOND OR
SUCCESSIVE HABEAS CORPUS PETITION (2254
PETITION) IN THE DISTRICT COURT THE
PETITIONER MUST REQUEST PERMISSION FROM
THE US COURT OF APPEALS (28 USCA § 2244(3)(A)).

⑤ THE PETITIONER CANNOT APPEAL OR FILE A
WRIT OF CERTIORARI ABOUT THE DENIAL OF
OF A SECOND OR SUCCESSIVE HABEAS PETITION
(2244 PETITION) FROM THE US COURT OF
APPEALS (28 USCA § 2244(E)).

⑥ IT IS TO THE PETITIONER'S UNDERSTANDING OF THE FEDERAL RULES THAT THE 90 DAY WINDOW TO FILE A WRIT OF CERTIORARI FROM "STATE COURT" WILL STILL RUN WHILE PREPARING AND WHILE HIS 2244 PETITION IS PENDING IN THE US COURT OF APPEALS.

⑦ THOUGH A 2244 PETITION WOULD BE THE BEST REMEDY FOR PETITIONER'S SITUATION, HE KNOWS IN THE COURTS NOTHING IS GUARANTEED AND FEARS "IF" THE US COURT OF APPEALS DENIES HIS 2244 PETITION, HIS TIME TO FILE A WRIT OF CERTIORARI WILL BE FORECLOSED AND THE INJUSTICE, CONSTITUTIONAL VIOLATIONS, HIS INNOCENCE, AND MISCARRIAGE OF JUSTICE THAT PETITIONER HAS ENDURED WILL NEVER BE HEARD. HENCE, THE REQUEST FOR A "STAY".

⑧ IN ORDER TO FILE A 2244 PETITION, THE PETITIONER NEEDS TO PREPARE A 2244 PETITION, A MEMORANDUM, A NEW 2254 PETITION, PRIOR 2254 PETITIONS AND ORDERS, AND SCHEDULE TIME IN THE PRISON LAW LIBRARY.

⑨ IN ACCORDANCE WITH 28 USC § 2244(D), THE US COURT OF APPEALS WILL DECIDE ON HIS 2244 PETITION WITHIN 30 DAYS. ADDING 30 DAYS TO THE ESTIMATED AUGUST 10, 2018 DATE (TIME TO GET 2244 PETITION IN MAIL TO 3rd CIRCUIT), THE PETITIONER SHOULD HAVE A DECISION FROM THE US COURT OF APPEALS BY SEPTEMBER 10, 2018. AS ANTICIPATED, THE DELAWARE SUPREME COURT DENIED PETITIONER'S APPEAL AND REHEARING EN BANC (SEE ATTACHED ORDER) AND HIS WRIT OF CERTIORARI WOULD BE DUE APPROXIMATELY BY SEPTEMBER 10, 2018.

⑩ "IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE" THE PETITIONER RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS THIS HONORABLE COURT TO "STAY" THE 90 DAY FILING DEADLINE OF HIS WRIT OF CERTIORARI FROM "STATE COURT" UNTIL ESTIMATED DECISION (IF DENIED) DATE FROM US COURT OF APPEALS OF SEPTEMBER 10, 2018 TO DECEMBER 10, 2018 TO FILE HIS WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THIS COURT FROM THE "STATE COURT" DECISION (SEE ATTACHED ORDER).

(1) THE PETITIONER WILL INFORM THIS COURT IF THE ~~US~~ COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE THIRD CIRCUIT GRANTS HIS 2244 PETITION.

(2) THE PETITIONER'S ISSUES IN THIS CASE WOULD SERVE THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND THE EXTENT OF THE INJUSTICES MAY EVEN SHOCK THIS COURT AND WOULD WARRANT THIS COURT'S POWER AND AUTHORITY TO CORRECT "A MANIFEST MISCARriage OF JUSTICE."

WHEREFORE, PETITIONER, BRUCE WOOD RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS THIS HONORABLE COURT FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS TO "STAY" THE FILING DEADLINE DATE OF HIS WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THIS COURT FROM THE DECISION FROM "STATE COURT" UNTIL DECEMBER 10, 2018 AND/OR ANY REMEDY/ORDERS THIS COURT DEEMS APPROPRIATE TO PETITIONER'S CIRCUMSTANCES "IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE."
