I received your letter, dated January 15, 2019, directing me to respond to the certiorari petition filed in the above-captioned matter by February 14, 2019. I am respectfully requesting an extension of time of 46 days, until Monday, April 1, 2019, in which to file my response.

I am in consultation with the Pennsylvania Attorneys General Office and other Pennsylvania prosecutors regarding how best to respond to the certiorari petition in this matter which concerns Bruton v.
