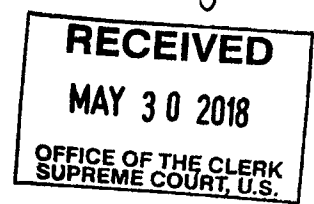
Dear Clerk,

I am in dire need of assistance. My \$2255 was denied by the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals on March 30, 2018. I have been preparing a writ of certiorari, prose, at the Yazoo City Correctional Complex. As you know I am only afforded 90 days in which to file a writ of certiorari.

Today, on May 18, 2018 I was told to report to R+D department on Monday, May 21, 2018, at 10 a.m. With all of my property. From my past experiences this usually means that an inmate will be transferred to different facility, and this process could take weeks to complete.

I believe that this transfer - right now - will impede my ability to complete an adequate writ of certiorari, and therefore, impede my access to the courts.

I would like to know what is required to file a request for an extension of time, and any other insights



into the dilemma that I find myself in. I would like to thank you in advance for your time and consideration pertaining to this very urgent matter.
