O R D E R

Luis Bonilla, Jr., seeks to appeal his sentence. The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Bonilla's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the plea agreement and the transcript of the Fed. R. Crim. P. 11 hearing, we conclude that Bonilla knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the issues Bonilla seeks to raise on appeal fall squarely within the scope of his waiver of appellate rights. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
