Appellant, pro se, moves for "relief under Rule 60(b)," which we construe as a motion for a certificate of appealability. Upon due consideration, it is hereby ORDERED that the construed motion is DENIED and the appeal is DISMISSED because Appellant has failed to show that "(1) jurists of reason would find it debatable whether the district court abused its discretion in denying the Rule 60(b) motion, and (2) jurists of reason would find it debatable whether the underlying habeas petition, in light of the grounds alleged to support the Rule 60(b) motion, states a valid claim of the denial of a constitutional right." *Kellogg v. Strack*, 269 F.3d 100, 104 (2d Cir. 2001).


We also construe the Appellant's papers as a request for an order authorizing the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York to consider a successive § 2255 motion, and,

as construed, it is ORDERED that Appellant's motion for leave to file a successive § 2255 motion is DENIED because he has not satisfied the criteria set forth in 28 U.S.C. 2255(h). *See also Tyler v. Cain*, 533 U.S. 656, 663 (2001).




