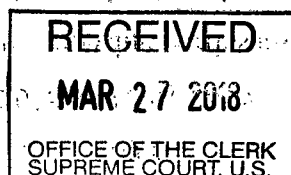
Because of my disadvantages and the estate issues, I need more than normal three months for filing my petition
