Motion For Extension To File Writ Of Certiorari
To The Honorable Justices Of Said Court:

Now Comes, Craig Mack, Petitioner in this cause pursuant to United States Supreme Court Rules 30(2), and will show this court the following facts:

1. On June 01, 2018, the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals in Cause No: 17-50770, USDC No: 6:15-CV-236 entered an ORDER denying Petitioner's Certificate of Appealability.
2. This ORDER was delivered to Petitioner by this facility mailroom Personnel on June 19, 2018. On June 24, 2018, Petitioner filed a Notice of Appeal with the Clerk of The Fifth Circuit.
3. Thereafter, on July 06, 2018 petitioner wrote the Clerk of The United States Court of Appeal requesting to receive two copies of the appropriate forms to file the Writ of Certiorari.

4. On July 25, 2018, Petitioner was transported to Hospital (H.G.) Galveston due to blood in his urine and thereafter, returned to MICHAEL UNIT on July 31, 2018.

5. On Friday August 03, 2018, Petitioner received one(1) copy of the requested forms from the U.S. Supreme Court Clerk.

6. Then on August 10, 2018 Petitioner was transported back to Hospital Galveston, and then returned to the BYRD UNIT that night 08/10/2018, and then returned back to H.G. on August 15, 2018 for a procedure; and then returned back to MICHAEL UNIT on August 16, 2018.

7. Once again on August ²¹21, 2018, Petitioner was transported to H.G. and instead of being housed on the BYRD UNIT enroute to the MICHAEL UNIT, The State Classification Committee rerouted Petitioner and five other prisoners to the WYNNIE UNIT where "we" were housed in Administrative Segregation without Just Cause.

8. Today, August 28, 2018, Petitioner was transported back to the MICHAEL UNIT and placed in Administrative Segregation due to the fact that this facility does not have enough room to house the senior citizens and disabled prisoners who are one row, bottom bunk restricted only.

9. Therefore, the Prison System refuses to transfer Petitioner to another Prison for his documented physical disabilities; Petitioner has not be afforded adequate amount of time to file the Writ of Certiorari since he received the forms (August 03, 2018.)

10. Petitioner, therefore, was unable to meet the 10 day before the final date to file the Writ of Certiorari to file this extension requesting extra time.

11. Petitioner do hereby respectfully request that the court will grant him an extension of twenty-one (21) additional days to file ~~said~~^{cm} said Writ of Certiorari.

Wherefore, premises considered Petitioner Pray that this court would please take into consideration the fact that fifteen days of this month "alone", Petitioner has been absent from his assigned facility and without access to any of his legal documents to file for a Writ of Certiorari or an extension of Time to file.
