Application For Extension Of Time To File A Petition For Writ Of Certiorari

Tiby Saunders Gomez, Petitioner, *Pro se*' works as a licensed independent financial professional (Series 7 and 66) with a fiduciary obligation to both clients and family seeks an extension of time hereby respectfully request The Honorable Justice Samuel Alito, Jr. pursuant to Rule 30 (2) for 60 additional days to submit an application for writ of certiorari:

1. The Petitioner's time for filing certiorari is tolled on September 26, 2018 and pursuant to Rule 30, Petitioner sets forth this application at least 11 days before the specified final filing date.
2. The Petitioner wants to address specific judicial decisions from the state courts in Delaware and New York surrounding the subject matter jurisdiction issue, and three (3) Constitutional questions that affects both Federal and state laws. This will require additional time to complete the research and the proposed writ of certiorari for a discussion with potential counsel for their review.

SUPPORTING FACTS WARRANTING EXTENSION

3. Petitioner is diligently acquiring and compiling the legal research needed to perfect and support her petition and prepare the application pursuant to the US Supreme Court rules in booklet format and as a layperson this will be difficult but worth the challenge.

4. Petitioner seeks to employ Amicus Curiae Counsel, as Rule 37.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of United States provides. Petitioner seeks to employ counsel who is admitted to practice before this great court, as Rule 5 requires.
5. The Petitioner has (3) three other legal matters in New York City, a probate matter in New York County since 2005 that was stayed in May 2015 and this requires a final motion as discussed in our August 22nd conference; a landlord/tenant eviction proceeding and both matters are *pro se*', and a civil matter before the New York Supreme Court of New York County with counsel. And, as the primary provider for my household and being self employed, my income is essential to our livelihood.
6. Petitioner feels that provided the requested extension is granted, she will demonstrate that the interest and pursuit of justice will be better achieved. Petitioner will have the needed time to place a more comprehensive document before this court.
7. The application for writ of certiorari is near the final stage of completion and the orders/decisions from the courts are attached.

Wherefore, the Petitioner respectfully prays that the Honorable Justice S. Alito will grant a 60 day extension to the time allotted to end on November 26, 2018 or whatever this court deems just and proper.
