

**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner asks for leave to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendices without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. In both underlying state court proceedings, Petitioner has been granted indigent status. See attached Applications for Criminal Indigent Status, dated July 25, 2014 (state trial court) and dated November 17, 2017 (state appellate court).

A copy of the Affidavit or Declaration in Support of Motion for Leave to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* has been sent to the incarcerated Petitioner, but counsel has not yet received a signed copy. Out of an abundance of caution, Counsel

files the instant Motion, along with the Petition and Appendix, and can correct the filings, if necessary, once the Affidavit is received.

**CONCLUSION**

Based upon the foregoing authorities and arguments, this Court should grant the Motion, or grant leave to correct the Motion after receiving the successive supporting Affidavit.
