Wheeler, Case No. 18-420 (S.Ct. 2019). The Wheeler case presented questions similar to Millis's certiorari petition, yet this Court's disposition of the Wheeler case resulted in Wheeler's 28 USC § 2241 petition being remanded to the district court for further proceedings, whereas Millis's § 2241 petition was not remanded for further proceedings.
