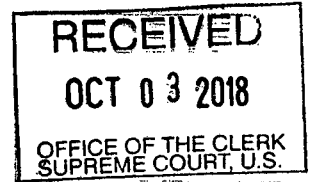

Request for 60 day Extension

Dear Sir:

I am respectfully submitting this request for a 60 day Extension Of Time to file my Writ of Certiorari pursuant to Sup. Ct. R. 30.2. The United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit denied Thomas's petition for rehearing and/or rehearing en banc on July 09, 2018.

Thomas is currently incarcerated at FCI Yazoo City Low, in Yazoo City, Mississippi. However, since the denial of his most recent petition mentioned above Yazoo City Low has been dealing with an ongoing epidemic of the high usage of synthetic drugs (i.e. K2 or spice). This drug causes inmates to have out of body experiences, such as frequently throwing up; walking around like a zombie; laid out on the floor; being rushed to the outside hospital; and several other out of body experiences.

As a result of the before-mentioned episodes, staff are forced to increase the Unit shake-downs, suspend privileges and modify all movement, especially to the law library until the Administration rid the institution of its current problem.

In order to be right, exact and adequate upon Thomas submitting his Writ of Certiorari to this Court, consideration in granting this 60 day extension of time request is warranted.
