The pro se appellant was DENIED leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis by the appellate court on September 25, 2018 and was given fourteen (14) days to pay the \$505.00 filing fee. The pro se appellant has not paid the \$505.00 appellate fee. Accordingly,
