Judgment

Though the Applicant has filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*, his pleading is not subject to the advance payment of court costs so that motion was not considered.


Though styled a petition for habeas corpus, the Applicant is actually attacking his conviction and sentence. A claim contesting the validity of a conviction or to have a sentence set aside is considered an application for post-conviction relief. *Sinclair v. Kennedy*, 701 So. 2nd 457 *writ denied* 717 So. 2nd 645 (La. App. 1st Cir. 1997); *State ex rel. Lay v. Cain*, 691 So. 2nd 135 (La. App. 1st Cir. 1997); *State ex rel. James v. State*, 640 So. 2nd 259 (La. App. 1st Cir. 1993). An application for post-conviction relief must be filed in Washington Parish where the Applicant was convicted. La. Code Crim. P. art. 925. The time limit for filing for such relief has passed.

The Applicant has alleged no valid claim that may be raised in an application for a writ of habeas corpus.

For the above reasons:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Application of David Lee Williams filed on August 10, 2018 is DISMISSED.


