
**APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

TO: The Supreme Court of the United States or any Justice thereof empowered to act on this application, or the Clerk of said Court empowered to act on this application.

Petitioner hereby applies to this Court for an extension of time to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.

Petitioner is seeking review of a decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit on January 16, 2018. Petitioner sought rehearing of that decision by the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit, and that court denied rehearing on April 26, 2018. Petitioner believes that without an extension, his petition would be timely only if filed by July 25, 2018, in accordance with Rule 13 of this Court.

Petitioner is incarcerated in a Minnesota State Correctional facility and has limited access to the prison law library and legal materials. Case law that he seeks to use to support his petition is not available in the prison and must be sought by request to the Minnesota State Law Librarian, a process that takes approximately 3 weeks for each request. Petitioner is without legal counsel.



Petitioner therefore prays that this court will grant him an extension of a reasonable time in accordance with the practices of this Court to allow him to fully research and properly prepare his petition.


