On 31 October 2017, this court held a hearing to determine if the respondent should be committed to the custody and care of the Attorney General pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4246. For the reasons stated in open court, the court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that the respondent is presently suffering from a mental disease or defect as a result of which his release would create a substantial risk of bodily injury to another person or serious damage to the property of another. It is hereby ORDERED that the respondent be committed to the custody and care of the Attorney General pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4246. Because respondent was sent to this district by order of the Western District of Kentucky, under 18 U.S.C. § 4241(d), having been charged with a crime or crimes by that court, the Clerk is further DIRECTED to send a copy of this order to the Clerk of Court for the Western District of Kentucky, Gene Snyder United States Courthouse, 601 West Broadway, Room 106, Louisville, Kentucky 40202.
