Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request a 30-day extension, to Monday, March 11, 2019, to file their response to the petition for certiorari.

On January 9, 2019, the Court directed respondents to file a response to the petition by February 8, 2019. I am counsel of record for respondents, who request a 30-day extension to file their response for two reasons: in light of my responsibilities on other matters, and to ensure that they have enough time to review and respond to the arguments raised in the Petition, in the supporting amicus brief already filed by the Goldwater Institute, and in another amicus brief that the Pacific Legal Foundation has said it intends to file (to which respondents have consented).
