



Dear Justice Gorsich,

I am hereby respectfully requesting a 60-day extension of time to file my writ of certiorari. Please also clarify if the new due date is based upon the prior Mandate's issued date or filed date. Below is the information required for this application for extension of time:

1. Jurisdiction. The Supreme Court of Kansas denied Johnson's Petition for Review on August 31, 2018. The court filed its Mandate on September 17, 2018, copy is attached. Johnson's writ of certiorari is due in 90 days: on approximately November 31st (if based on Mandate's issue date), or on December 17th (if based on the Mandate's filed date). Thus, Johnson timely



files this application more than 10 days before either date. The jurisdiction of this court is involked under 28 U.S.C. § 1257(a).

2. Judgment sought to be reviewed. Johnson seeks review of the Supreme Court of Kansas case no. 13-110837-A, where Johnson then sought review of the Opinion issued by the Court of Appeals of Kansas. That Opinion is attached per Rule 13.5. Such is from Johnson County District Court case no. 12 CR 1074.


3. Reasons why. Johnson requests a 60-day extension of time for the following reasons:
