I am requesting an extension of time to file a Writ of Certiorari due to extraordinary circumstances where I need additional time to file my petition.

The basis for jurisdiction in this case is Rule 10 of 28 U.S.C. #1257, and 1st 14th Amendments violations.

The judgment was in case # 17-0975 in the Texas Supreme Court of no opinion and opinion orders was in the First Court of Appeals Case # 01-16-00431-CV and The 505th District of Fort Bend County, Texas which are in direct conflict of both with no legal basis of law or statutes for either ruling. My brother passed away on September 13, 2018 and the funeral was on September 22, 2018. Under these extraordinary circumstances, I have been overwhelmed with trying to be


