





I certify, under penalty of perjury, that on April 18, 2019, the enclosed petition for a rehearing regarding the Writ of Certiorari, Petitioner states that the grounds presented are limited to the intervening circumstances of controlling law under Mathis v. United States, 133 S. Ct. 2276 (2013), and further to the thus applicable effects of the Armed Career Criminal Acts qualifications of an enhancement past the 10-year maximum of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g).
