The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

TONY D. THOMPSON v. THE STATE

Appellant, who pled guilty to murder and other charges in 1998, seeks to appeal the trial court's May 11, 2018 order denying his motions for an out-of-time appeal from the July 1998 denial of his first motion to withdraw his guilty pleas and for counsel and an evidentiary hearing on that motion. This Court has already affirmed the trial court's order dismissing a May 2001 motion that was construed as an untimely motion to withdraw his guilty plea, see Thompson v. State, 274 Ga. 818 (559 SE2d 730) (2002), and dismissed his later efforts to appeal the trial court's 2011 orders denying motions in which he sought an out-of-time appeal from the July 1998 order denying his first motion to withdraw his guilty pleas, counsel to assist with that appeal, and an evidentiary hearing, see Thompson v. State, S12D0543, S12D0599 (Jan. 5, 2012). Because appellant is essentially seeking an unauthorized duplicative appeal, this Court lacks jurisdiction. See Richards v. State, 275 Ga. 190, 191 (563 SE2d 856) (2002). Accordingly, the Court hereby dismisses this appeal.
