
REASONS WHY AN EXTENSION IS NEEDED:

Since being transferred to this new institution on 06.06.2018 the Petitioner has:

- 1) Encountered insurmountable problems trying to do any legal work from his cell due to it being a 4-man cell but built for 2, and all those situational problems, rotational use of restroom: loud music, etc.
- 2) The scheduling is horrible with multiple, multiple passes being sent to petitioner while law library is scheduled at ACI.
- 3) The Applicant is usually unable to leave his block until his block is called to chow--thereby missing law library partially and virtually always the use of the law computers as it's first come first serve with only 3 law computers allocated for the entire camp, (1200 to 1500 inmates).
- 4) Then finally many, many times the law computers have been down, out-of-service, and this happens too frequent, SEE ATTACHED EXH-3 from the ACI's Law Librarian, Mrs. Denise Carder, affirming the status of the law computers access at ACI.

Wherefore, the Applicant prays this court grant said extension from the Brief's due date of October 10th, 2018 until December 10th, 2018, 60 day extension for these good causes.


