I represent the respondent, Ralph Diaz, Acting Secretary of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, in the above-entitled case. The petition for writ of certiorari was filed on February 26, 2019. On April 1, 2019, this Court requested a response. The brief in opposition to the petition is currently due on May 1, 2019. I respectfully request that the time for filing that brief be extended thirty-days, to Friday, May 31, 2019. I have not previously requested an extension to file the brief in opposition.

I am requesting additional time because, when this Court ordered a response to the petition on April 1, 2019, I had to direct my attention to completing the respondent's brief in a previously-assigned capital case, *People v. Poore*, California Supreme Court Case No. S104665, which was filed on April 19, 2019. I have turned my attention to the above-entitled case.

Additionally, the filing of the brief in opposition will require an extensive review process in consultation with the Solicitor General of California. This process cannot be completed without the requested extension of time.
