MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

COMES NOW, the Petitioner, **BRYAN FREDRICK JENNINGS**, by and through undersigned counsel, and moves for leave of this Court to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this proceeding.
