**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED
*IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

The Petitioner, Brian Wright, by and through his court-appointed counsel, Angela H. Dows, respectfully requests this Honorable Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in filing the attached Petition for Writ of Certiorari. In support of this request, Petitioner states that undersigned counsel was appointed pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, and he is unable to retain counsel and pay for the costs attendant to the proceedings before the Honorable Court.

Petitioner, who is currently serving a federal prison sentence in a separate matter, and has yet to serve the 15 month supervised release portion of his instant
