In each of these appeals, Petitioner-Appellant James F. Oliveira seeks a certificate of appealability in relation to the district court's denial of his motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2254.

After careful review of the record below and of the petitioner's submissions before us, we conclude that the petitioner has failed to make "a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right." 28 U.S.C. §2253(c)(2); see Slack v. McDaniel, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000).

Petitioner-Appellant's motion for leave to appeal in forma pauperis is denied as moot.
