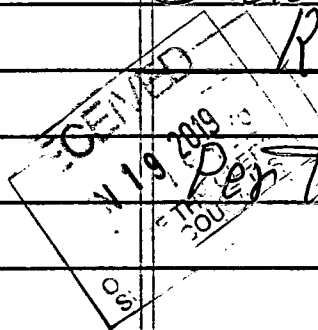

I hereby certify that the petition for rehearing is presented in good faith and not for delay.

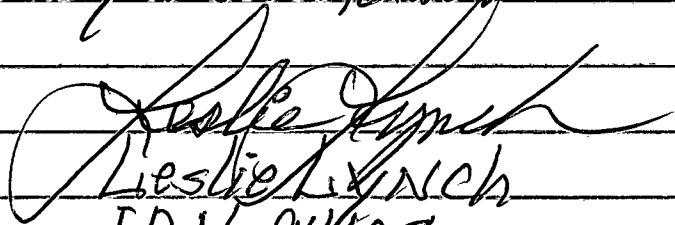

May 13, 2019, ruling, as:

I
By this court's denial of my writ is condoning
the states courts denial of due process rights
guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution, Amendment
14, section one
... Nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction
the equal protection of the laws.

(Idaho Constitution, Article I

Section 3, The State of Idaho is an inseparable
part of the American Union, and the
Constitution of the United States is
the supreme law of the land.

Section 13, ... No person shall be ... deprived of life,
Liberty or Property without due process
of law.

Section 18, Courts of Justice shall be open to
every person, and a speedy remedy

afforded for every injury of person,
property or character, and right and
~~the~~ justice shall be administered
without sale, denial, delay, or
prejudice.)

The Idaho courts denied my Constitutional
rights to due process by not adhering to
Idaho criminal rule 11-C.

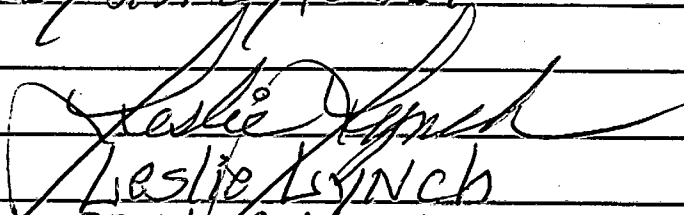
