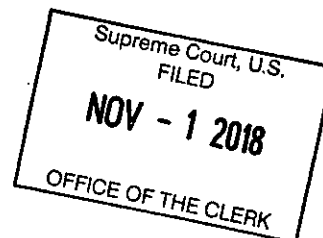


MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

DECLARARION
IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

I, Elicia Bailey, am the petitioner in the above entitled case. In support of my motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*, I state that because of my poverty I am unable to pay the costs of this case or to give security therefor; and I believe I am entitle to redress.

My average gross monthly income before taxes is \$2,280. My net monthly income after taxes is \$1,400 with \$500 toward child support included. My total monthly expenses are \$1,310 and include as follows:

Rent: \$400

Utilities: \$150

Child Support: \$500 (included with monthly income after taxes)

Car: \$360

Food: \$100

Laundry: \$30

Phone: \$40

Storage: \$150

Gas: \$80

I am divorced and have no assets save life insurance that is provided and paid for through my employer. I share an apartment with another individual and pay the lesser of the rent but I pay all utilities in full. I am not financially able to

afford the costs of prepaying to file the enclosed Writ of Certiorari without
burdening myself.
