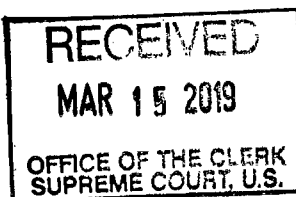


**MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS***
