ORDER

The matter before the court is Defendant Bjorn Christian Luster's pro se "Motion Seeking Permission to Cohabitate with Another while on Probation" ("Motion") (docket no. 61), which was filed on November 19, 2018. In the Motion, Defendant states that he "is nearing release" and desires "to reunite as a family under one roof" with his ex-wife and child, but "does not want to violate his probation by consorting with [his ex-wife who is] a felon." Motion at 1. The Motion is **DENIED**. Defendant is instructed to work with his Bureau of Prisons caseworker/counselor, who can consult with the appropriate probation officers to determine his release plan.
