MOST OF MY EARNINGS, AND A MONTHLY STIPEND PROVIDED BY MY SISTER AND MOTHER, ARE USED TO DEFRAY COMMUNICATION EXPENSES WITH MY FAMILY. MY WIFE LEFT EMPLOYMENT, AFTER NEARLY TWENTY YEARS WITH THE SAME EMPLOYER, TO VENTURE INTO A SMALL BUSINESS. THUS, WE ARE CASH FLOW POOR AND WILL BE FOR SOME TIME TO COME.
