Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I write on behalf of Respondents Exelon Corporation, R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant LLC, Constellation Energy Nuclear Group, LLC and Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, LLC (collectively, "Constellation") to request, or in the alternative, confirm, a thirty-day extension of time, until Monday 11, 2019, to file Constellation Respondents' opposition to the petition for certiorari.

The petition was docketed on January 7, 2019. Briefs in opposition were initially due on February 8, 2019. On January 15, 2019, the New York State Respondents filed a motion to extend the time to file a response by 30 days. On January 17, 2019, the Court granted that motion and entered the following text on the docket: "Motion to extend the time to file a response is granted and the time is extended to and including March 11, 2019."

The Court's docket text does not clearly state that the time to file a response has been extended for all Respondents. Accordingly, out of an abundance of caution, Constellation Respondents file this request with the Court. A 30-day extension is requested to afford the Constellation Respondents time to review the petition and amicus curiae briefs expected to be filed on February 8, 2019.
