For Writ Of Certiorari


Dear Clerk:

Pursuant to Sup. Ct. R. 13.5, I am respectfully offering this pleading for a 60 day extension of time to file a writ of certiorari. On November 14, 2018, the Sixth Circuit denied My Rehearing and/or Rehearing En Banc.
