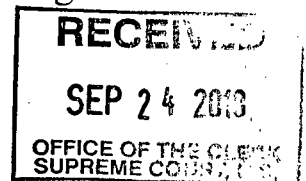
APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR

To the Honorable Steven Breyer, Justice for the First Circuit:

Petitioner Kevin Watkins requests an extension of time to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari. He respectfully requests an extension of 60 days to file. The final judgment and denial was entered on the docket below on June 29, 2018, and the time to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari will expire on September 27, 2018. This application is being filed 10 days prior to the aforementioned due date.


The lower court's final order denying review is attached. The jurisdiction of this court is invoked under 28 U.S. Code § 1257(a). There are important questions, including double jeopardy, the right to open trials, the right to counsel, and other issues which were determined adversely by the court below.

The petitioner is proceeding pro se and was unable to get the file from my attorney appointed below over the summer. I only just received it on August 23, 2018. The file box I received appears to have been damaged in



transit and resealed. The papers inside were scrambled and incomplete, and some have what appear to be footprints on them.
