I write on behalf of Respondent Wendy Kelley to request a 45-day extension of the July 3, 2019 deadline for filing a response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned matter. An extension would make the response due on August 16, 2019.

I respectfully submit that a 45-day extension is reasonable and necessary because of other professional obligations, including primary responsibility for several other actions in multiple federal and state trial and appellate courts. Additionally, the Solicitor General Unit of the Arkansas Attorney General's Office recently assumed primary responsibility for filing a response to the petition for certiorari and will require additional time to become sufficiently familiar with this matter to file a response.

I also respectfully submit that Terrance Proctor is incarcerated and unrepresented by counsel, so obtaining his consent to this request is impractical.
