The petition for a writ of certiorari was docketed on January 11, 2019, and responses are currently due on February 11, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that their deadline to respond to the petition be extended by 28 days to Monday, March 11, 2019.

The requested extension is necessary because respondents were recently advised that the Native American Intellectual Property Enterprise Council intends to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of the petition. Respondents seek additional time so that they can incorporate any necessary response into their brief in opposition. In addition, several lawyers at my law firm who have taken an active role in previous briefing in this case are currently heavily engaged in preparing an expedited brief that is due February 15, 2019, in *BTG International Ltd. v. Amneal Pharmaceuticals LLC*, Nos. 19-1147 et al. (Fed. Cir.) (previously before this Court on an emergency application in No. 18A539).

I have conferred with Counsel of Record for petitioners, who has advised that petitioners do not oppose this request for an extension.
