Dear Mr. Harris:

On behalf of petitioners, I write to advise the Court of a recent development relevant to the above-captioned case. As the petition for certiorari explained, the Puerto Rico Supreme Court's decision and the seizure order that it reinstated forced the Archdiocese to seek the protections of bankruptcy. Pet.2. On March 18, 2019, however, the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico purported to apply that decision to justify dismissing the Archdiocese's bankruptcy petition, reasoning that the Archdiocese could not proceed because not all of the Catholic dioceses covered by that decision were participating in the bankruptcy proceedings. See In re Archdiocese of San Juan, No. 18-04911 (Bankr. D.P.R. Mar. 18, 2019) (enclosed). The Puerto Rico Supreme Court's decision thus has now had the collateral effect of foreclosing the Archdiocese's only remaining avenue save review by this Court for attempting to mitigate the disastrous consequences of the erroneous decision below.
