MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner John Loveman Reese respectfully moves to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP), pursuant to Rule 39 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, in connection with his filing of a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. Petitioner is an indigent prisoner on Florida's death row.

Petitioner was previously granted IFP status by Florida's state and federal courts. Counsel of record, Christopher J. Anderson, was appointed to represent Petitioner by the Duval County Circuit Court, under Fla. Crim. Pro. Rules 3.111 and 3.112, on March 26, 2015. Petitioner's co-counsel in this Court, the Capital Habeas Unit of the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida,

was appointed to represent Petitioner in federal court by the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, under 18 U.S.C. § 3599, on October 17, 2017.
