I am counsel for Respondent Jena McClellan in the above-referenced case. On January 17, 2019, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case. 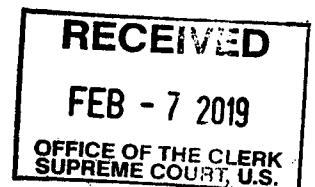
