

The mail is placed in a mailbox and picked up at the end of each day (or the end of the weekend if placed on a Friday) and postmarked sometime after pick-up. In some limited cases, a member of the Fairton Camp Authorities, if available at that time, provides a certification of special mailing when requested. If available, a copy is included herein.
