ORDER

Before **TYMKOVICH**, Chief Circuit Judge.

This matter is before the court on attorney Lynn Pierce's *Unopposed Motion to Withdraw and for the Appointment of Counsel for Defendant/Appellant from the 10th Circuit CJA Panel*. Upon consideration, the motion is granted. The district court has made the requisite finding of eligibility for appointment of counsel, and James L. Hankins is appointed as counsel for Appellant Timothy J. Stubbs pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, effective immediately.
