THEY WERE "IMMUNE" FROM 5TH AMENDMENT VIOLATIONS AS RES JUDICATA.

THEY SAW ONLY DOLLAR SIGNS IN RETAINING FRANK AND JENNIFER; ROBBING US OF PRECIOUS TIME TOGETHER, WHICH CAN NEVER BE REPLACED.

THEY SHOULD BE LIABLE TO FRANK AND JENNIFER FOR THE HELL THAT THEY PUT THEM THROUGH; AS ORIGINATING FROM THAT HORRIFYING, EVIL; RACIST LITTLE TOWN.

Background Information:

Danea, a native of Florida, where she allegedly married and divorced Frankie's father, became a resident of Indiana in 1982 when she moved to New Castle from Orlando with Joe Stegner, a New Castle native. She states that while in Florida, she completed high school and one year of college, before moving to Indiana. (A)

(1) Danea was forced to leave Florida, according to Beverly Stegner, because of difficulties with the authorities concerning her care of Frankie, non-payment of rent, and an assaultive encounter with her landlord. Upon their return to New Castle, Joe and Danea lived with Cecil Stegner, Joe's parents. On May 6th of 1983, the two were married; they were divorced on October 13th of the same year. Although Beverly states that Joe was very fond of Frankie, he did not adopt him. During this period Beverly and Cecil supported the couple with food, lodging, and child care. (2)

Beverly became quite attached to Frankie during '82 and '83, and has continued to pursue her relationships with him as 'Grandma.' Observers state that she is very loving and permissive with the child. Beverly has attended to Frankie's medical needs, and been solely responsible for his care on several occasions when Danea was 'indisposed.' (3) (4)

They didn't like strangers, and their ways become a vicious, sinister game. After efforts to make Michelle "disappear," her children fall victim to their evil with no hope of ever returning.

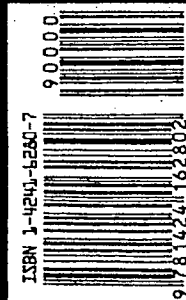
Yet Michelle finds supernatural protection, and a dream from the Divine becomes her strength to fight to free her children.

She lives in Indianapolis, where she has two grown children and five grandchildren. She works as an impressionist artist.



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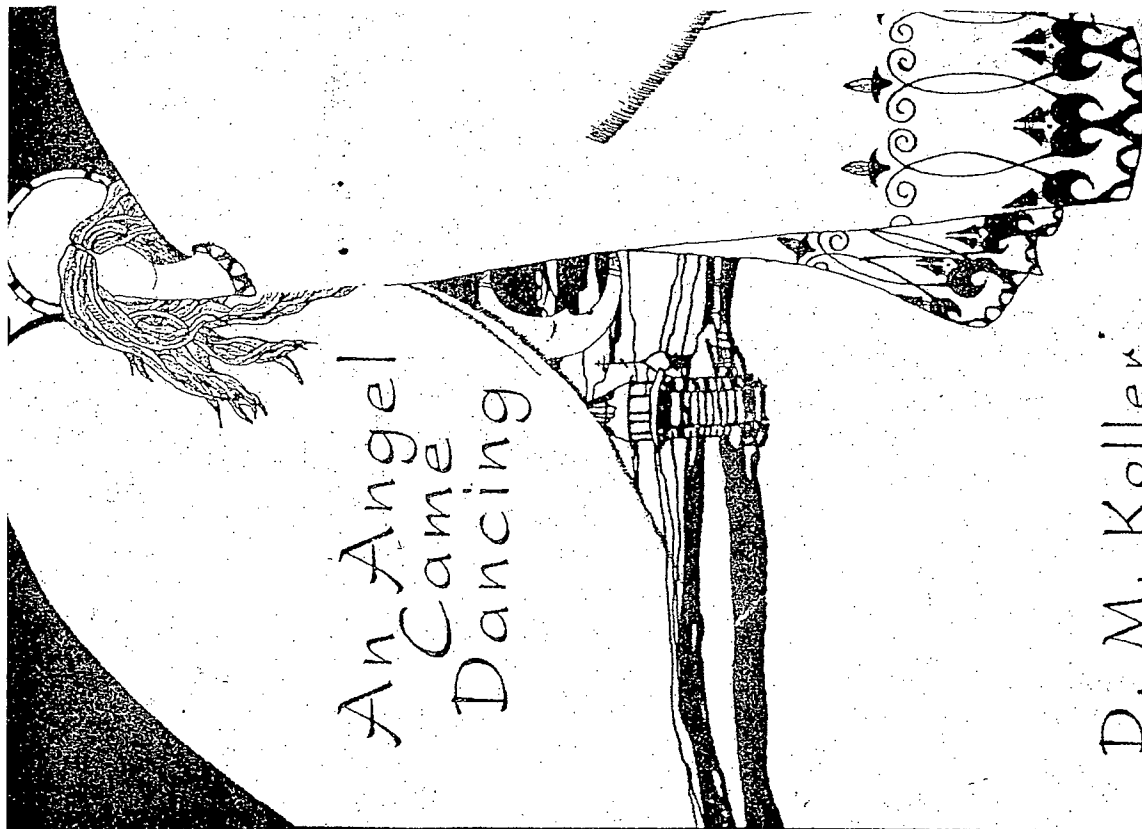
