I represent the County of Jackson, a respondent in the above-referenced matter. A Petition for a Writ of Certiorari from an October 22, 2018 decision was filed on January 22, 2019, and placed on the docket on January 25, 2019. Waivers were filed by the co-respondent City of Jackson and the within County on January 30, 2019 and February 7, 2019, respectively.
