I represent the County of Jackson, Respondent in the above-referenced matter. On January 22, 2019, Plaintiff in the lower court matter filed a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari from an October 22, 2018 decision. The Petition was placed on the docket on January 25, 2019. On February 7, 2019, Respondent waived an initial response. On February 27, 2019, the Court requested a response to the petition.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondent previously sought and was granted additional time to file a Response to Plaintiff's Petition to June 28, 2019. Thereafter, the Court was in recess with the first conference of the new term scheduled for October. Respondents seek a final extension of time to September 25, 2019, though their Response likely will be filed in advance of that date, caused by an extreme press of business and defense counsel's absence following her minor child being diagnosed with an autoimmune disease, resulting in multiple hospitalizations, surgical procedures, and continuing treatment requiring counsel's presence.
