I represent the County of Jackson, a respondent in the above-referenced matter. A Petition for a Writ of Certiorari from an October 22, 2018 decision was filed on January 22, 2019, and placed on the docket on January 25, 2019. Waivers were filed by the co-respondent City of Jackson and the within County on January 30, 2019 and February 7, 2019, respectively. On February 27, 2019, the Court requested responses to the petition. On March 29, 2019, the County sought an unopposed 30-day extension of time due to conflicting deadlines in previously-pending matters and counsel's scheduled absence from the office for long-scheduled travel commitments. That request was granted on April 4, 2019.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondent County respectfully requests an unopposed second 30-day extension of time to and including May 27, 2019 within which to file a brief in opposition necessitated by an extreme press of business including a petition for rehearing en banc in *Liogghio v Salem Township* in the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, Reply Briefs in two Michigan Supreme Court cases where the opposing parties filed their Briefs in Opposition almost four months late, an Appellee Brief in *Graves v Monroe* in the Michigan Court of Appeals, a Brief in Opposition in *Brennan v Dawson* in this Court, and oral arguments scheduled in both the Michigan Court of Appeals and the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit requiring preparation in both and out of state travel in the latter.

This request is made in good faith and not sought for any improper purpose. I have conferred with Counsel of Record for Petitioner who concurs in the requested extension.
