We represent Respondent in *Mitchell v. Tulalip Tribes of Washington*, No. 18-970. The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on January 23, 2019. The Court requested a response on March 5, 2019. The current deadline for that response is April 4, 2019. We were recently retained as counsel for Respondent and are still familiarizing ourselves with the case and record. In addition, several other professional obligations will make it difficult to complete our response brief by the current deadline. As such, we respectfully move for an extension of time to file Respondent's response brief, to and including May 6, 2019.
