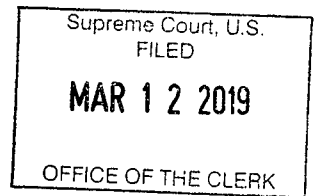

QUESTION(S) PRESENTED

The Appeal Court dismissed the case with no reason, because Forma pauperis was granted for filing fees but they continued to ask for payment of the filing and docketing fee. The prisoners account has no money because the Petitioners are only detained and don't work and don't have any sources. The Court withdrew money from the account without paying attention that the Forma pauperis is granted and deprived the Petitioners even from the last 0.95 cents in their prisoners' accounts, which were supposed to be used for stamps.
