
The Petitioner has appealed to this Court from an order of the District Court of Tulsa County denying his application for post-conviction relief – requesting a post-conviction appeal out-of-time in Case Nos. CF-1972-2266, CF-1972-2267, CF-1972-2269 and CF-1972-2270. In those cases, Petitioner entered pleas of guilty and was convicted and sentenced. Petitioner did not seek to withdraw his pleas within applicable time periods, and thus failed to perfect direct appeal proceedings from his Judgment and Sentences. Petitioner filed an application for post-conviction relief that was denied by the District Court, and his post-conviction appeal was dismissed by this Court as untimely. *King v. State*, No. PC-2017-1063 (Okl.Cr.






